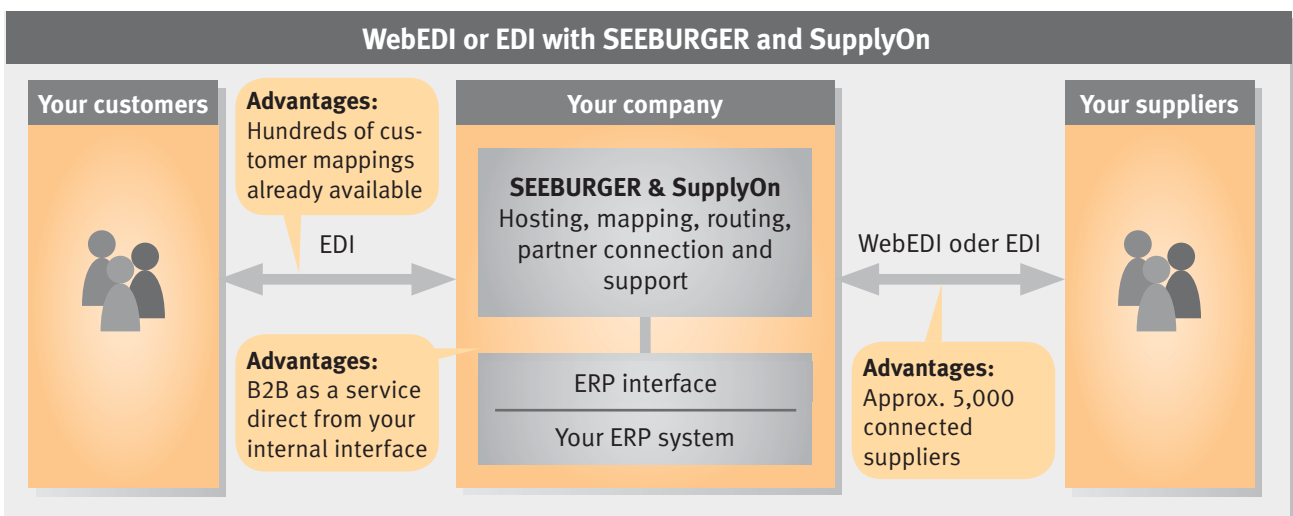
Challenge
