

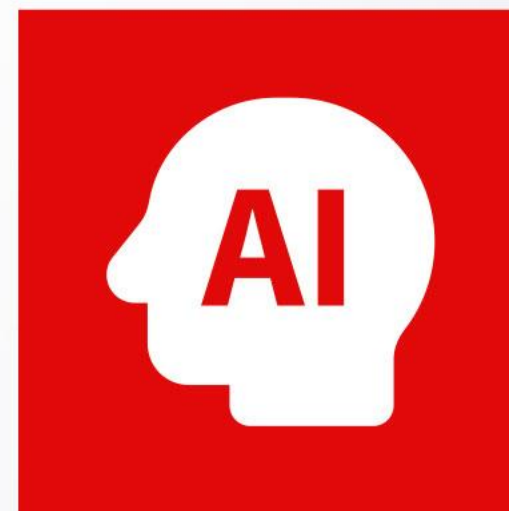

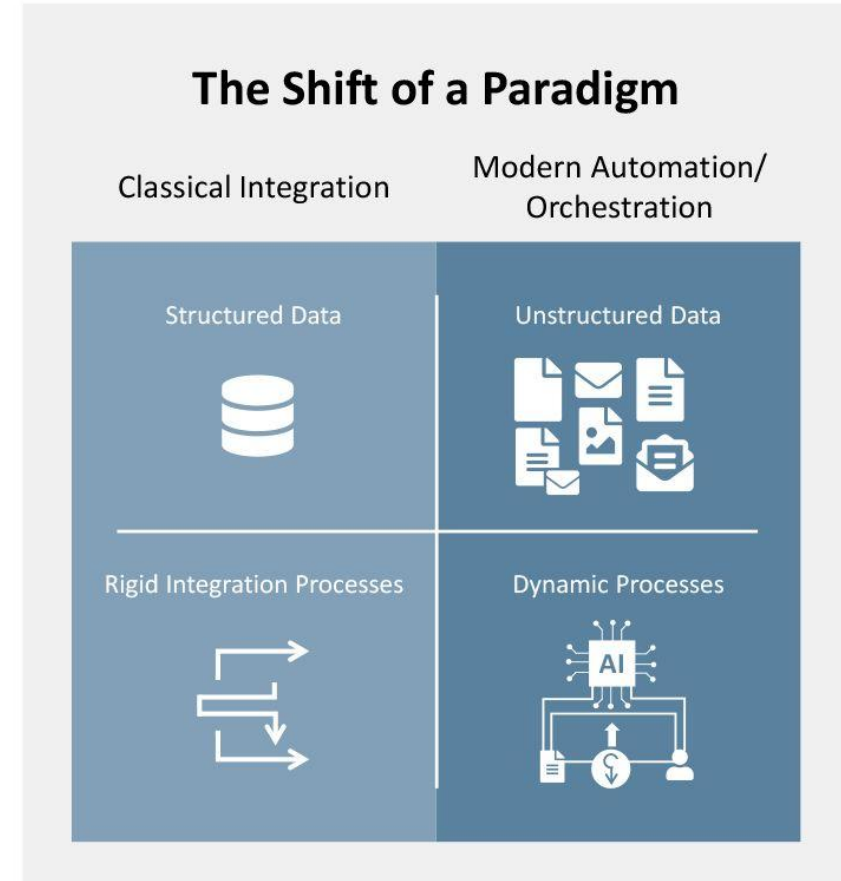

Intelligent Automation (Deterministic AI Workflow)

strict, deterministic automation

The Logic

Combines the stability of classic automation with the flexibility of LLMs.

How it Works

Embeds an LLM Model directly into a static, linear workflow.

The process path is fixed, but the AI supports with it's unique capabilities.

Autonomous Agents (Agentic Workflow)

dynamic, autonomous reasoning

The Logic

Shifts from following a script to active decision-making and reasoning.

How it Works

Uses a Reasoning Engine to analyze broad objectives rather than linear steps.

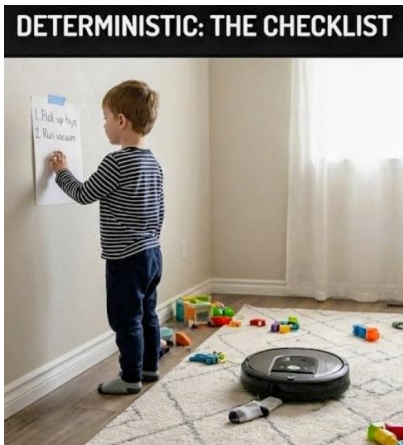
Iterative Loops

Autonomously selects and executes specific "Agent Tools" to solve problems.

The Kid & The Messy Room

The Goal: A clean room.
The Tools: Hamper, Toybox, Vacuum Cleaner.



Intelligent Automation (Deterministic AI Workflow)

strict, deterministic automation

The Checklist Approach

The Command

1. Pick up toys.
2. Run the Vacuum.

The Logic

Rigid steps. The vacuum runs exactly when the list says so.

The Risk

If a sock is left on the rug, the vacuum sucks it up (because the list didn't say "check for socks first").

Autonomous Agents (Agentic Workflow)

dynamic, autonomous reasoning

The Goal-Driven Approach

The Command

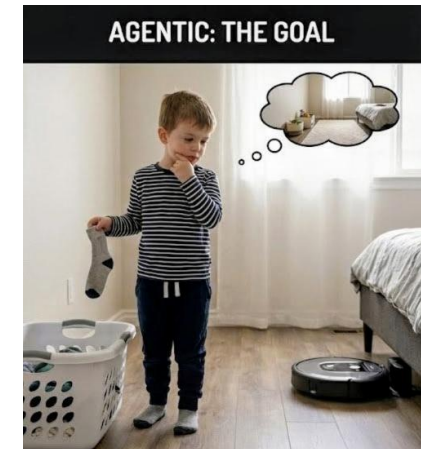
Make the floor clean.

The Logic

The Kid (AI) looks at the floor and selects the Vacuum.

The Reasoning

Wait, there is a sock on the rug. I will move the sock to the hamper first, then I will vacuum.

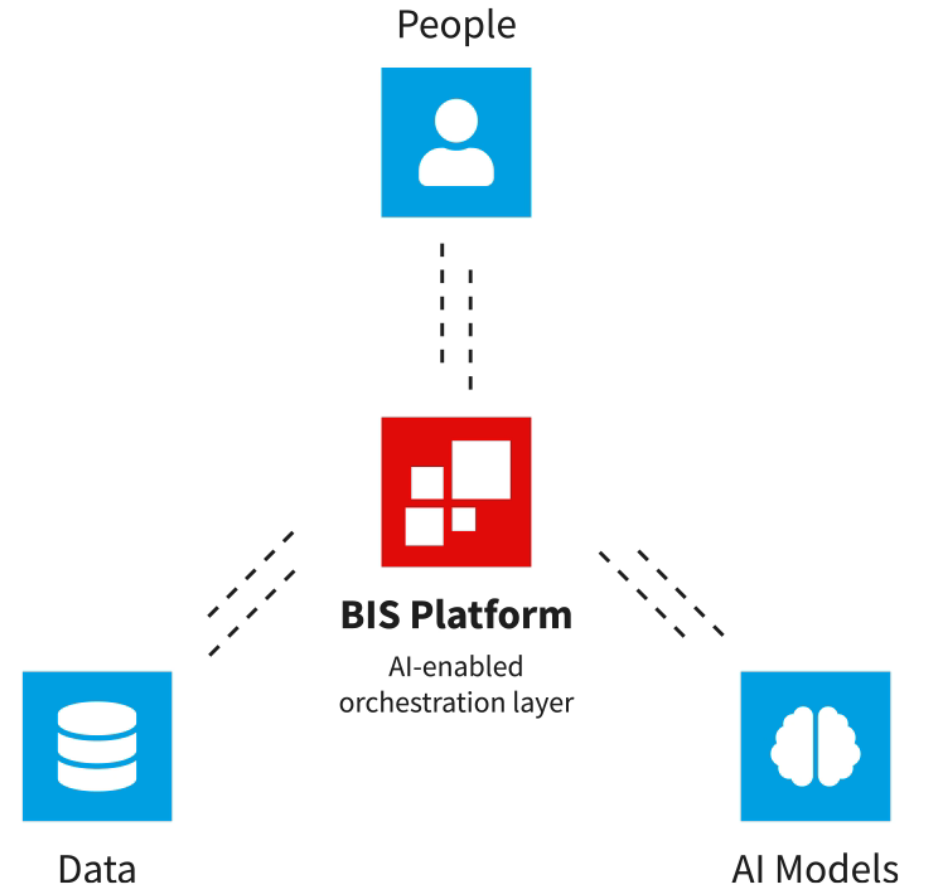

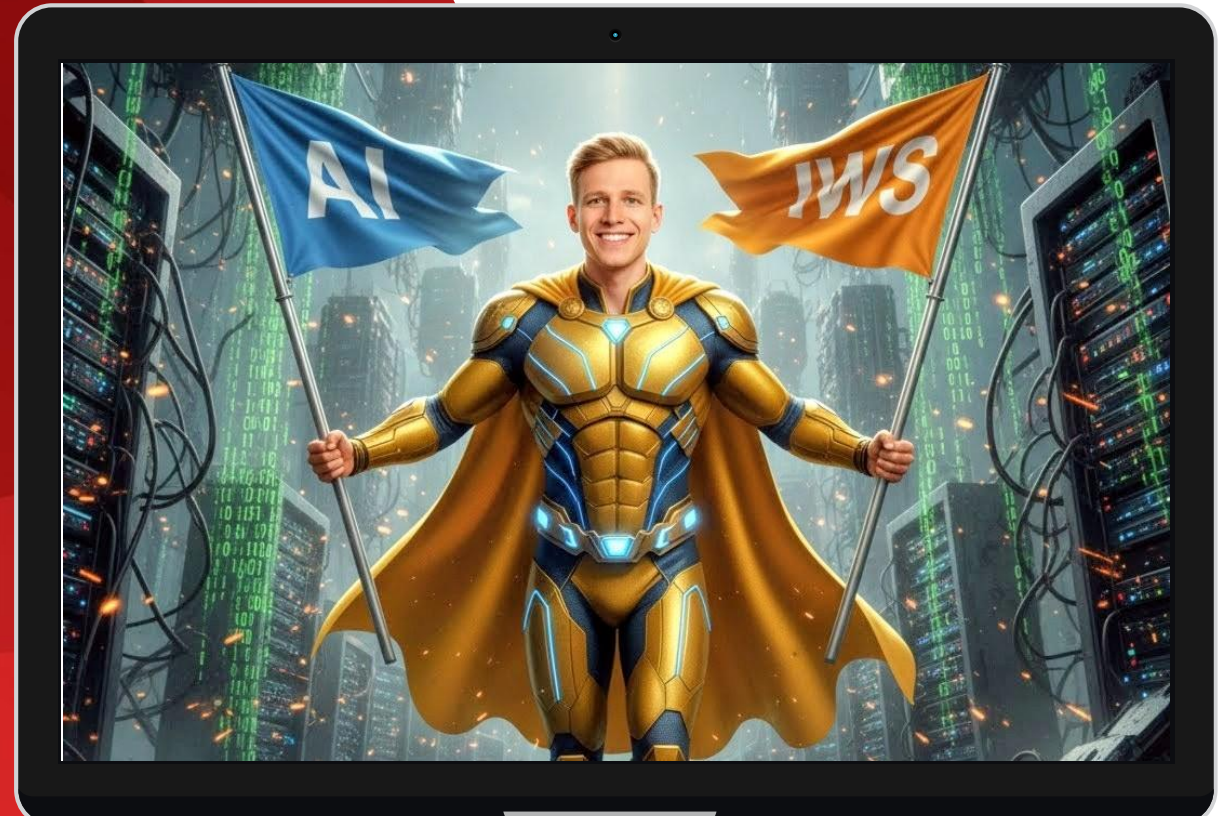
